- CPPS development started April 2019
- Questions written in October 2019
- Exam assembled in November 2019
- Passing score estimated in February 2020
- Opened for application portal May 2020
- Exam opened in September 1st
- First exam was taken on September 1, 2020
- 28 individuals conferred the CPPS in 2020
- January 31, 2021 deadline for the March Exam


James C. Ball Lifetime Achievement Award
