






2021 TLVs® and BEIs®

Numerous sea containers arrive with high levels of hazardous volatile chemicals, including carcinogens, in the interior air. This presents a serious health risk during inspection and unstuffing. The problem remains largely unaddressed due to ignorance, lack of suitable field instruments for chemical identification, and lack of suitable ventilation methods. The webinar would address three topics: (1) which chemicals are found in the air of containers arriving in Sweden and at what levels, (2) personal exposure of workers unstuffing containers, and (3) a new, easy to use and efficient method ventilation of containers prior to unstuffing.

Clusters of disease have occurred associated with disturbance of asbestos-containing rocks. The appearance of potentially hazardous minerals often comes as a surprise when construction is not taking place in areas of known asbestos mining. Serpentine is so common in California that it is considered the official State rock, but it typically hosts the asbestos mineral chrysotile, and other minerals may also be encountered. Minerals are defined by chemical composition and crystallography. A suite of amphiboles is regulated because they had been mined for asbestos, but other amphibole compositions exist with different names and these can also be problematic.

Herbert E. Stokinger Award

Initiated in 1977, the Herbert E. Stokinger Award recognizes significant contributions in the broad field of industrial and environmental toxicology. The award's namesake served as Chairman of the Chemical Substances Threshold Limit Values Committee from 1961–1975.

The Stokinger Lecture, presented by the awardee, is an annual highlight of the American Industrial Hygiene Conference and Exposition (AlHce).

Meritorious Achievement Award

The Meritorious Achievement Award recognizes members of ACGIH® who have made an outstanding, longterm contribution to the progress of occupational health and environmental hygiene. First presented in 1957, it is the organization's oldest award. It has been given to individuals for singular achievement and to groups for collective accomplishment.

William Steiger Memorial Award

The William Steiger Memorial Award honors individuals from the social/political sphere whose efforts have contributed to advancements in occupational health and safety. Initiated in 1979, this award is not limited to occupational safety and health professionals.

John J. Bloomfield Award

The John J. Bloomfield Award was established in 1978 and is presented annually to a young industrial hygienist who has made significant contributions to the profession by pursuing occupational health hazards, primarily through fieldwork. The recipient must have at least three but less than ten years of experience in occupational health and must spend a minimum of 50 percent of his/her time conducting industrial hygiene studies and documenting the data involved.

The Bloomfield Award recipient is invited to Board of Directors' meetings as a special guest for one year, followed by one year with a major committee of their choice.

William D. Wagner Award

The William D. Wagner Award was established in 2003 and is presented annually to honor a person in the field of national and international worker health and safety who has followed Mr. Wagner's outstanding example of commitment and dedication to the creation and dissemination of occupational exposure values (OEVs).

The Award recipient will be chosen each year by one of the ACGIH® OEV Committees on a rotating basis.

The OEV Committees will make nominations and the awardee will be selected at least six months prior to the applicable Committee's fall meeting. The Award will be presented at the Committee's fall meeting. The Awardee will be invited to speak to the OEV Committee and guests on some aspect of international worker health and safety.
